### Peter said you killed Him! Paul said He died for us!

Acts 2:22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:

Acts 2:23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain:

Acts 2:24 Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it.

### Peter is accusing Israel of killing Jesus

Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.

Acts 2:37 Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Again Peter is accusing Israel of killing Jesus. Many people use this for their salvation. I have noticed when people do that, most of them when you talk to them have no assurance of salvation, but that's for another day.

Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.

Acts 3:14 But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

Acts 3:15 And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses.

Acts 4:8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, Acts 4:9 If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; Acts 4:10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

## Peter is Still accusing Israel for crucifying our Lord Jesus Christ. Does it sound like he thought it was a good thing?

Acts 5:26 Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they feared the people, lest they should have been stoned.

Acts 5:27 And when they had brought them, they set them before the council: and the high priest asked them,

Acts 5:28 Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach in this name? and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us.

Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.

Acts 5:30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

Acts 7:51 Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye.

Acts 7:52 Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? and they have slain them which shewed before of the coming of the Just One; of whom ye have been now the betrayers and murderers:

### Peter said this

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Acts 10:39 And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree:

Peter's message was to Israel that they killed him! Peter said you killed him!

#### Paul said he died for us!

### Paul presents It as good news! Gospel of the grace of God!

Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

Romans 1:1 Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God,

Here is says that Paul was separated unto the gospel of God.

Romans 1:3 Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;

Romans 1:4 And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:

Romans 1:5 By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations (Gentiles), for his name:

Romans 1:6 Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ:

### Paul was Looking at it from a different angle than what Peter was looking at it in the book of Acts. After God revealed it to him.

- 1 Corinthians 1:17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.
- 1 Corinthians 1:18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

### Paul's mission was to preach the cross, resurrection.

- 1 Corinthians 1:23 But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness;
- 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

### All throughout Pauls epistles he preaches Christ crucified as good news.

- 1 Corinthians 15:1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;
- 1 Corinthians 15:2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.
- 1 Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;
- 1 Corinthians 15:4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

# That is the gospel of the grace of God, for our salvation! And it still works to this day! All because of what Jesus did for us on that cross! Hallelujah!

- 2 Corinthians 5:15 And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.

Ephesians 2:16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

### Paul always talks about the cross/resurrection...

Philippians 2:8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Philippians 3:18 (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:

Did you stop and think how many churches only preach about the cross, maybe only 2 or 3 times a yr? Wouldn't that be considered enemies of the cross of Christ? How many times do we hear a religious person talking about the blood that was shed on that cross? I can remember many times sitting there for hours and not once was Jesus Christ even mentioned, but a person heard plenty about the old patriarchs, Noah, Abraham and Moses

Colossians 1:20 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.

Colossians 2:14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

1 Thessalonians 4:14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

In Acts when Peter talked about the cross/resurrection he was accusing Israel of killing him, over and over he was accusing Israel for what they had done. Told them(Israel) that they must repent and be baptized for what they had done, so they could receive the Holy Ghost.

Paul talks about the cross/resurrection as a good thing, that Jesus died for us. No one looked at it that way until God revealed it to Paul. Then it was good news.. All a part of Gods plan!

Ephesians 3:3 How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

1 Corinthians 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

Galatians 1:12 For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

- 1 Corinthians 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:
- 1 Corinthians 2:8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

### Even the 12 apostles didn't know it....

Luke 18:31 Then he took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished.(Isaiah 53)

Luke 18:32 For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on:

Luke 18:33 And they shall scourge him, and put him to death: and the third day he shall rise again.

Luke 18:34 And they understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken.

(Also Mark 9:31 and John 20:9)

After I finished putting this together, I noticed that Peter rebuked Israel 7 times.

Then just out of curiosity, I looked up the word CROSS, how many times Paul mentions it and it was 10 times. Then I also looked up the word CRUCIFIED and it also was in Paul's epistles 10 times.

I think the number 10 in scripture is complete and perfect number.

10 the whole unit..

Just think of the 10 commandments.

So we conclude that Peter preached the crucifixion as YOU KILLED HIM! And that Paul preached the crucifixion as GOOD NEWS!

PETER = YOU KILLED HIM! PAUL = JESUS DIED FOR YOU!!
